#### **Who and Where We Are**

\*Located in Lincoln, OR, the OE May Term provides a safe space for college students to study issues of gender and faith.

\*Lincoln is a renovated 1920's logging camp . Located 21 miles from the nearest town, it provides students with a sanctuary for hiking, reading, and discussion.

\*May Term is held every other year. Our next program happens May 18 – June 8, 2011.

\*Women return to their campuses more confident to speak their needs as students and to engage the academic, social, and spiritual fabric of their campuses and their world. Men leave May Term with insight into the ways culture shapes masculinity and return to their campuses freer to respond creatively to the issues confronting women and men.

### *Extend your mind...*

#### **Curriculum**

\*May Term is a fully accredited program, offering 3 hours of college credit in the following subject areas: Bible, theology, literature, psychology, or sociology.

\*Classes run from 9 AM – 12:30 PM on weekdays. We reserve afternoons, evenings and weekends for conversations with faculty, reading, research and genuine relaxation.

\*Instead of the traditional classroom set-up, students learn through a combination of lectures, discussions, and individual research projects. Integrating personal experience with academic learning is paramount.

\*By selecting a topic and working closely with an individual faculty member, students create a research project in their subject area of choice and present their findings at the close of May Term.
